## **Heritage Auctions BSA Art Collection**

We are pleased to announce that the Trust has begun the process of selling the substantial art collection that was assigned to it by BSA under the terms of the BSA plan of reorganization. All proceeds of the sales will benefit Survivors of childhood sexual abuse in Scouting.

The Trust's art collection includes works by Norman Rockwell, Walt Disney, and J.C. Leyendecker, among many others, and depicts Scouting in some of the most recognizable and beloved imagery in American art. For the past several years, many of these works have been on display at the Medici Museum of Art in Warren, Ohio.

Judge Houser, as Trustee, retained Heritage Auctions, one of the world's largest and most respected auction houses, to assist her in the liquidation of the Trust's art collection. Twenty-five pieces of the Trust's art collection will be auctioned on November 15, 2024, including Rockwell's 1961 *Homecoming* and Leyendecker's 1918 *Weapons for Liberty*.
