ORDER GRANTING MOTION OF THE HONORABLE BARBARA J. HOUSER (RET.), IN HER CAPACITY AS TRUSTEE OF THE BSA SETTLEMENT TRUST, FOR APPROVAL OF AMENDMENT OF TRUST DISTRIBUTION PROCEDURES

The Honorable Barbara J. Houser (Ret.) (the "Trustee"), in her capacity as trustee of the BSA Settlement Trust (the "Settlement Trust"), filed a motion (the "*Motion*") for an order approving the Trustee's proposed 60-day extension of the deadline for Direct Abuse Claimants to elect the "Independent Review Option" pursuant to the Trust Distribution Procedures ("TDP") under the *Third Modified Fifth Amended Chapter 11 Plan of Reorganization (With Technical Modifications) for Boy Scouts of America and Delaware BSA, LLC*, No. 20-10343 (LSS) (Bankr. D. Del. Sept. 6, 2022), D.I. 10296 (the "*Plan*").

Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 105(a), and this United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware possessing jurisdiction over the Motion pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334, the *Amended Standing Order of Reference* from the United States District Court for the District of Delaware dated February 29, 2012, and Article XI.C of the Plan; and this Court finding that it may enter a final order consistent with Article III of the United States Constitution; and venue in

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this District being proper pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1408 and 1409; and this being a core

proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b); and due and proper notice of the Motion having been

provided and it appearing that no other or further notice need be provided; and having considered

the Motion and all papers related thereto heretofore filed; and the relief requested in the Motion

being warranted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED THAT:

1. The Motion is GRANTED as stated herein.

2. Capitalized terms not otherwise defined herein shall have the meanings ascribed to

such terms in the Motion.

3. The 120-day extension of the deadline to file Independent Review claims is approved.

The deadline to file Independent Review claims is February 16, 2024.

4. This Court retains jurisdiction to interpret and enforce the Plan and Confirmation

Order, this Order and other orders entered in the instant case.
